

HR. RATE AFTER DEDUCTIONS:

- Total amount remitted to Local #5 for Vacation, Local Dues, OADC Dues, Market Advancement, Local Building Fund, Apprentice Fund, Industry Fund, Health and Welfare, and Pension is \$24.14.
- Total amount remitted to International Pension Fund, IU Dues, PPA and International Masonry Institute is \$2.99.
- Total Fringes Per Hour: \$27.13
 - 1.) The employer is to deduct \$5.27 per hour Vacation, Dues Check Off, Local Building Fund and Market Advancement from the taxable hourly rate and include it with the non-taxable fringes of \$21.86 per hour for a total of \$27.13 per hour when sending in contributions to the funds office.
 - 2.) All overtime hours are to be paid at Time and One-Half the regular rate, including all payments to Health & Welfare, Pension, International Pension Fund, Vacation, Apprentice, Industry, IMI and Dues Check Off (all working dues).
 - 3.) Double time is to be paid after the first two hours of overtime Monday through Friday and after the first ten hours on Saturday. All other hours, Sundays and Holidays, shall be paid at the double time rate.
